Key responsibilities include: The programme aims to train future scientists able to work in highly competitive environment and with abilities to work across disciplines. 1. have a master degree in chemistry, material science, or related fields
2. have a good background in chemistry and skills expected for the appropriate subject of PhD Programme
3. have a good command in English
4. be under 30 years of age.

1. **application form** (including information on cumulative average grade for the studies, publications and presentations at scientific conferences, awards and prizes, scholarships)
2. **cover letter** with the photograph of the applicant
3. degree certificates
4. **a candidate who successfully passed the entry examination to a PhD programme (physics, chemistry and related domains) during the last two years and completed no more than one year of the studies should present appropriate documentation**
5. **a letter of recommendation** from a scientist who is familiar with the applicant's previous achievements and who can judge his\her potential as a PhD-student.
