TRAINING WORKSHOP IN SELF-PRESENTATION AND PUBLIC SPEAKING SKILLS

At the completion of the 2 - day training participants should have:

- An appreciation that science information presented in the form of a narrative is not only possible, but preferable for engaging an audience, including the media, and convincing them of the value and possibilities which science offers.
- An understanding of the ingredients of narrative and how these ingredients can be used in different ways to structure effective scientific presentations.
- A simple method for planning a pitch presentation to capture attention and to persuade the audience (whether peers, public, media or funding bodies) of the importance and value of an idea or piece of work.

The training will give each individual participant:

- Opportunities to practice structuring and presenting the content of their own work in two different ways, with constructive feedback.
- Opportunities to practice techniques to control public speaking nerves and be 'master or mistress' of the stage during public presentations.
- A set of handouts covering course material and further tips on visuals, room layout etc.



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
