I hereby declare that:

1. I have read this application to the FNP START programme, in particular, the list of the candidate's scientific accomplishments and the description of the candidate's individual contribution to these accomplishments.
2. I have read the *Rules for stipends for young researchers in the START programme of the Foundation for Polish Science*, in particular with respect to the rights and obligations of the research supervisor, and I will comply with these rules.

I acknowledge that the Foundation for Polish Science processes my personal data for the purpose of the organization and implementation of the FNP START programme, including verifying and evaluating the candidate's application, evaluating and documenting the course of the programme. The data will be retained for the period necessary to organize and implement the programme and administer the scholarship, and, subsequently, in accordance with the Foundation's applicable document retention rules and for the period necessary to establish, exercise or defend any legal claims (5 years).
